KINNESTON HORSES IN TRAINING 2023 – WELCOME

Welcome to Kinneston and thank you for your interest in our team of horses for the 2023-24 National Hunt Season. Compiling this book is always a pleasure as it gives me a chance to assess the prospects of each horse and it looks as though we have an exciting team of horses across the spectrum, some high class established horses along with plenty of excellent young prospects that with luck will show the benefits of patience shown to date.

Whilst last season failed to match the previous season in terms of number of winners our prize money total increased by 15% and our prize money per runner was up by over 20%. I see the latter as a key metric and with your support I plan to continue to try to place the horses in races that offer better prize money. Our win and place percentages were very solid and apart from 10 days around Christmas the horses were consistently running well.

We are fortunate to have had very low staff turnover this summer and I am delighted with the Team we have going forward; there is a focussed and energetic approach to doing the job and a genuine team ethos that continues to be recognised nationally.

There are changes afoot in the way our race programme is structured with the imminent introduction of "Premier" racing. Creating an aspirational culture in sport is essential and whilst most of every Trainers' runners will be running at core fixtures we will be doing our utmost to be playing a part at the "Premier" level.

HANDICAP CHASERS



DUBAI DAYS (IRE)

2014 Bay Gelding by Dubai Destination (USA) ex Comeragh Girl (IRE) (Imperial Ballet) – Rating 127c 122h

Owner: Alexander, McGarrity, Morris & Parker

Another excellent season for Dubai Days saw him winning at Carlisle and finishing a very close second in the valuable Hillhouse Quarry Handicap Chase at Ayr. An exceptionally versatile and genuine horse, he might well find further improvement this season with stepping up to 3 miles a possibility.



ELVIS MAIL (FR)

2014 Grey Gelding by Great Pretender (IRE) ex Queenly Mail (FR) (Medaaly) - Rating 143c 137h

Owner: The Ladies Who

He won in October and March last season and was 3rd in the valuable Skybet Chase in January. His only blip was unseating at the Cheltenham Festival when he reverted to hurdles. His most recent start was probably a career best when winning in great style stepped up to an extended 3m at Kelso – staying is now clearly his game but he also has class and speed so with luck he should have an exciting season.



GIPSY LEE ROSE (FR)

2014 Grey Mare by Walk In The Park (IRE) ex Vanoo D'Orthe (FR) (Valanour) – Rating 88c 91h

Owner: Sarah Irwin

Very consistent without winning last season until we went to the well once too often in April (her 8th start). She should put that behind her and is now handicapped to win having come down 13lb since this time last year, prefers a track that brings out her stamina and likes plenty of cut in the ground.



NED TANNER (IRE)

2016 Bay Gelding by Milan (GB) ex Rose Tanner (IRE) (Roselier) – Rating 120c 117h

Owner: Hands and Heels

A progressive young chaser who won twice last season and despite that goes into the new season only 3lb higher than a year ago. Effective at 2m 4f or 3m depending on ground conditions he has the right profile to move up to a higher level as a second season chaser, his form reads very well.

NICEANDEASY (IRE)

2013 Bay Gelding by Kalanisi (IRE) ex High Priestess (IRE) (Priolo) – Rating 110c 110h

Owner: Katie and Brian Castle

He lost his way last season having been highly tried subsequent to falling 2 out when running a massive race in the Borders National at Kelso last December. He looked booked for 2nd that day and would be 7lb lower this time round should we chose to go that route. Either way he looks well handicapped if we can get his confidence back, an early spin over hurdles might be the answer.



NOT THE CHABLIS (IRE)

2014 Bay Gelding by Scorpion (IRE) ex De Street (IRE) (Sunshine Street) – Rating 93c 85h

Owner: Turcan, Dunning, Price, Stewart

A winner of a bumper, hurdle and chase he had an accident in his stable just after his comeback run at Musselburgh last season. We gave him time to get over that and he finished the season with a much better run when beaten 2l at Perth in May. The form of that race has worked out very well so there are plenty of reasons to believe he can win more races off what is a career low handicap mark.

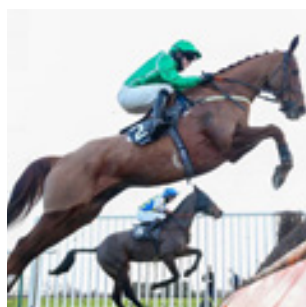


UP HELLY Aa KING (GB)

2011 Chesnut Gelding by And Beyond (IRE) ex Gretton (GB) (Terimon) – Rating 123c 114h

Owner: Jean Matterson & Judy Douglas Miller

A star for the yard he had a lucrative 2022/3 season despite failing to win. High level Veterans Chases are his patch these days and having been 2nd at Haydock in November he then ran an excellent race to be 4th in the valuable Veterans Final at Sandown. He then finished the season with what was possibly a career best at Doncaster in February. All being well he will follow a similar route this time round.



WAVELENGTH (FR)

2015 Bay Gelding by Gentlewave (IRE) ex Mrs Percival (GB) (Lahib) – Rating 102c 100h

Owner: Mrs J Walker

He won at Hexham in May 2022 and unfortunately picked up a minor injury that day that caused us to decide to leave him off last season. Having found the key he looks potentially very well handicapped so should be competitive if he can pick up where he left off, 3 miles is his trip now and good to soft ground ideal for him.



NOVICE CHASERS



ARTIC MANN (GB)

2014 Bay Gelding by Sulamani (IRE) ex Line Artic (FR) (Freedom Cry) - Rating 103c 105h

Owner: Alexander, Baxter & Jardine-Paterson

Artic Mann missed the whole of last season having picked up a minor injury in early 2022. We've given him plenty of time and he will probably have a couple of runs over hurdles prior to resuming his chasing career. He has never really had a chance to fulfil his potential so hopefully patience will be rewarded and his time will come.



ARTIC ROW (GB)

2017 Bay Gelding by Yeats (IRE) ex Line Artic (FR) (Freedom Cry) - Rating 91h

Owner: Ken McGarrity & Walker, Wheeler, Wheeler

Younger brother of Artic Mann, he was kept very busy in his first season for the yard running 10 times (a record?) He won once and ran some good races in defeat, most particularly on his latest start in May when he stayed on strongly to be a close third suggesting he might improve for a step up in trip.



DONNY BOY (IRE)

2016 Bay Gelding by Westerner (GB) ex Lady Roania (IRE) (Saddlers' Hall) - Rating 125c 125h

Owner: Mrs Lynne Maclellan

Winner of a point-to-point, bumper and hurdle; expectations were high when he went chasing last season but things didn't go to plan. He returned to somewhere near his best when runner up in a valuable race back over hurdles at Kelso in March. He can be forgiven his subsequent effort on very holding ground at Newcastle and certainly shouldn't be written off as a chaser this time round - older and wiser he could be progressive.



FORTESCUE WOOD (IRE)

2015 Bay Gelding by Westerner (GB) ex Primrose Time (GB) (Alflora) - Rating 126h

Owner: Bowen & Nicol

Lightly raced but highly talented Fortescue Wood won two novice hurdles last season from his three starts to add to his bumper win. The form of his recent impressive win has worked out particularly well and he's an exciting prospect for novice chasing.

HIGH ROLLER (FR)

2017 Grey Gelding by Al Namix (FR) ex Mandchou (FR) (Mansonnien) - Rating 95h

Owner: Turcan, Dunning, Borwick & Wemyss

A tall, big striding gelding by a top French sire out of the dam of the talented Friend or Foe he proved weak last season but showed ability and should improve for a switch to larger obstacles as he has always looked a chaser in the making.



TRAVAIL D'ORFEVRE (FR)

2016 Grey Gelding by Martaline (GB) ex Lady Needles (IRE) (Sri Pekan) – Rating 102c 107h

Owner: Bowen & Nicol

A bumper and hurdle winner that ran well over fences last season without winning most particularly on his latest start when finishing a close 3rd in the valuable Go North Series Final at Carlisle in March. This experience should stand him in good stead as a second season novice chaser and he remains well treated handicap wise.



WARRIORS STORY (GB)

2016 Bay Gelding by Midnight Legend (GB) ex Samandara (FR) (Kris) – Rating 101c 101h

Owner: The Warriors

He ran six times last season finishing a good second on three occasions and running poorly on the other three. Very hard to work out why he is so hard to catch right but he has plenty of good form in the book that suggests he will be winning again.

Has good form over fences so likely to go that route having reverted to hurdles latterly last season.

ATLANTIC DANCER (IRE)

2013 Bay Mare by Waky Nao (GB) ex Sarika (IRE) (Groom Dancer) – Rating 102h

A patient season for her was well rewarded with her winning twice and finishing 2nd twice looking better than ever at Kelso in April. She is perhaps a little more versatile going and trip wise than we previously thought so should have plenty of options to progress further, fences not ruled out either as she schooled well.

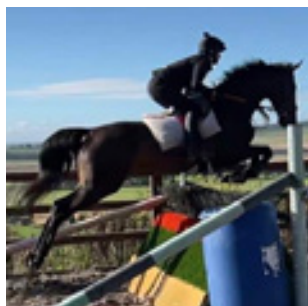


BEAT THE RETREAT (IRE)

Nicely bred we went to war early with him last season via the new National Hunt Juvenile Hurdle Series and he finished in the frame on the last three of his four starts. Hard to assess his form but I'd like to think he will prove well handicapped this season with that experience under his belt.



CANCAN (FR)

2016 Bay Mare by Al Namix (FR) ex Kestrel Mail (FR) (Cricket Ball) – Rating 107h

Owner: The Dregs Of Humanity

A consistent and genuine mare who has been placed on nine of her last ten starts, she missed last season thanks to a minor injury. She seems in great form again now and can hopefully pick up where she left off this autumn, perhaps stepping up in trip and fences also an option.



CHARM OFFENSIVE (FR)

2014 Bay Mare by Le Triton (USA) ex Go Lison (FR) (Turgeon) – Rating 121h

Owner: The Nags to Riches Partnership

Lightly raced but consistent and progressive last season, only out of the frame on one of her fourteen career starts. Suffered a mid-season setback in January and attempts to get her back on the track in the spring were only frustrated by the weather. Like to think that patience will pay off and she can have a busier time this season. 2m 4f to 3m, softer the better.

DUYFKEN (GB)

2019 Bay Gelding by Le Havre (IRE) ex Australienne (IRE) (Monsun) - Rating 105h

Owner: Douglas Miller, Coltman, Dunning, Turcan

2nd at Longchamp on his penultimate start on the flat in France last summer he took a while to get the hang of hurdling but finished the season well by finishing runner up in the valuable Go North Juvenile Hurdle Final prior to winning at Perth in April. He is well bred for hurdling and is open to plenty of improvement especially when he steps up in trip.



ELOI DU PUY (FR)

2018 Bay Gelding by Jeu St Eloi (FR) ex Martalina (FR) (Martaline) - Rating 94h

Owner: Coltman, Cundall, Matterson and Stephenson

A talented active type by a good sire that we are still to see the best of. Placed in a bumper and in four of his six hurdle starts he goes into his second season hurdling as a maiden which opens up plenty of options.



GINGER MAIL (FR)

2016 Grey Gelding by Sinndar (IRE) ex Queenly Mail (FR) (Medaaly) - Rating 118h

Owner: Judy Douglas Miller and Mary Coltman

Won on debut last season and finished a good second twice but his other three runs were disappointing most particularly when stopping quickly at Perth in April. Nothing came to light that day so it remains a mystery, should certainly win more races when all is right and fences are an option.



LACILA BLUE (FR)

2018 Bay Mare by Muhaymin (FR) ex Hispanola (FR) (Vangelis) - Rating 93h

Owner: Coltman, Douglas Miller, Matterson

An active, well-balanced, athletic filly who progressed nicely over hurdles last season. She looks nicely rated and as a maiden mare with an attractive rating there will be plenty of good options for her going forward.

MACK THE MAN (IRE)

2014 Bay Gelding by Flemensfirth (USA) ex Nifty Nuala (IRE) (Saddlers' Hall) - Rating 126c 111h

Owner: Alexander Family

Four time winner that we acquired in March this year, he has plenty of good form in the book and will prove nicely handicapped if we can persuade him to show his better form again.



MAILLOT BLANC (GB)

2017 Bay Gelding by Sulamani (IRE) ex Santoria (FR) Limnos) - Rating 105h

Owner: Kinneston Racing

A winner in January he was then kept busy by previous connections running a further five times before we acquired him in May. He seems versatile, consistent, hardy and the form of his last run has worked out well – fences will also be an option for him.

She gradually got her act together over hurdles last season and was only beaten 3l on her penultimate start prior to being brought down last time. She looks well handicapped and I would expect her to progress this season on the back of a recent wind operation.

Lovely, big, scopey home bred filly with a great temperament who has taken time to come together. She didn't handle conditions at Perth on her handicap debut and I hope will be better on a more galloping track over 3 miles.

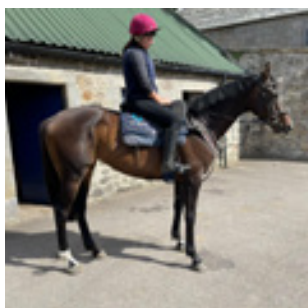


SANOSUKE (IRE)

2018 Bay Gelding by Galileo (IRE) ex Fix (NZ) (Iffraaj) – Rating 97h

Owner: Douglas Miller, Coltman, Dunning, Turcan

A winner on his last start on the flat he has taken a while to adapt to hurdling but the penny seems to have dropped now with him finishing 2nd on his last three starts getting closer each time. Up 9lb as a result but still looks well treated and as a maiden over obstacles with plenty of experience and a nice rating there should be plenty of options for him.



SEPTEMBER DAISY (GB)

An attractive forward going mare, having arrived here last summer it took time to identify her optimum conditions. 3 miles on goodish ground appears to be the answer and having run a good race in defeat at Wetherby in April she then won narrowly at Hexham in May. The form of that race has worked out well so there should be more to come when she has conditions in her favour.



STAINSBY GIRL (GB)

Love reading last year's comment in this publication when I said that she must be well handicapped if she could have beaten Elvis

Mail on her last two starts! For once I was right and she proved a star for the team last season winning three times including a valuable handicap at Haydock. She will be difficult to place now off her lofty rating so we will focus on trying to earn her some black type before she heads to stud.



THEME TUNE (IRE)

A well-bred, good-looking horse who had shown promise in his early hurdling career prior to losing his way and finding himself

at Kinneston a year ago. The Scottish air revived him and he won two nice races for new connections and ran well enough in defeat to finish his season in a valuable contest at Kelso in March. Handicapper may have his measure now but there could be more to come if we can improve his jumping.



ULTRA VIOLET (GER)

Our summer jumper has turned into a consistent sort of hurdler who just doesn't quite seem to know how to win. We will be doing our utmost to rectify that prior to this going to publication as there are plenty of nice races for him at Perth. Likely to then have a winter break and hopefully be back out in the spring.



WAKOOL (FR)

2016 Grey Gelding by Motivator (GB) ex Symba's Dream (USA) (Vindication) – Rating 141h

Owner: Turcan, Borwick, Dunning & Elles

Continued to progress last season showing good form at a high level winning the Grade 2 Rendlesham Hurdle prior to only being beaten 10l in the Pertemps Final at the Cheltenham Festival despite not having the run of the race. Will be tricky to place now and fences or the flat are options as well as graded hurdles.

2019 Bay Filly by Reliable Man (GB) ex Anyana (GB) (Nathaniel)

A gorgeous 4yo filly acquired at Deauville in July having won on the flat this year at Longchamp and Chantilly. She moves beautifully, loves jumping, has the right pedigree, likes soft ground and is an exceptional prospect for Mares Novice hurdles this winter.

BALLYFORT (IRE)

2019 Bay Gelding by Fame And Glory (GB) ex Mardale (IRE) (Robin Des Champs)

Owner: Maclay, Matterson and Warre

A lovely big loose-moving chasing type that we acquired from the Irish point-to-point field in May. He posted solid form when placed in three of his six starts between the flags and should have a bright future under rules. He is by a top sire and out of the high class winning mare Mardale; she was very much a two miler which suggests he may not have been seeing out the 3m in point-to-points.



BLUEBELL GLEN (GB)

This first foal out of our high-class mare Little Glenshee is by a top sire in Blue Bresil. She is a strong filly with a great walk and bags of presence who ran nicely in her bumpers last season ending up with a fine second at Hexham. She's improved again through the summer and should be progressive over hurdles.



CARRIGEEN KALI (IRE)

2018 Bay Filly by Soldier of Fortune (IRE) ex Carrigeen Kalmia (IRE) (Norwich (GB))

A very active, strong, good moving filly from one of the very best families by a top sire. Her dam was a high-class chaser and has already produced a good horse so she has plenty going for her. After an inauspicious start she improved in her bumpers and can be forgiven her final run. She schools well and I would expect her to take a step forward over hurdles up in trip.

CREAM OF THE WEST (IRE)

2016 Bay Gelding by Westerner (GB) ex Clare Hogan (IRE) (Moscow Society)

2nd in an Irish point-to-point prior to joining the yard in December 2020 when we chose to buy him instead of Corach Rambler. He has proved fragile and has been very lightly raced since. The Owners have been very patient with this promising son of Westerner and we were happy with his hurdling debut in January. Ignore his last run and watch him improve this time around.



HOMBRE DE GUERRA

2018 Bay Gelding by Solider Of Fortune (IRE) ex Lindy Lou (FR) (Hernando)

A big strong good moving horse who has had a patient upbringing. By the right sire out of a speedy Hernando mare who won on the flat and over hurdles and has already bred a winner.

He was disappointing in his bumper, not sure why but he left that form well behind him when finishing an eye-catching 5th on hurdling debut. That was good form and we decided to put him away to retain his novice status for this season.

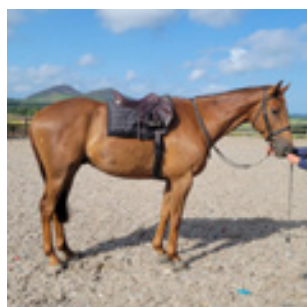


LANCE LES DES (FR)

Strong well made chasing type who is due to arrive at Kinneston in early September having been in pre-training with Will Biddick prior to a spell with Will Ramsay. His dam is from a top German family and won 3 races on the flat in Germany and was placed in a Group 3, she has already bred 7 winners. A lovely horse with plenty of class in his pedigree and has been given time, likely to run in a bumper before going hurdling.

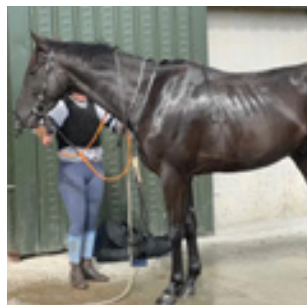


LUCKY SOLDIER (IRE)

A strong, good looking young horse by an ascending star of the stallion ranks and out of a Flemensfirth sister to Aye Right. He ran a great race to be second in his debut bumper but failed to build on that, he was then very green on hurdling debut but he is basically a good jumper and he certainly has plenty of ability that I am sure we will see this season.

A big strapping chasing type who ran very well to be 4th on his sole start in an Irish point-to-point. That was decent form and he should be able to make his mark over hurdles before he goes chasing. Might start off in a bumper.

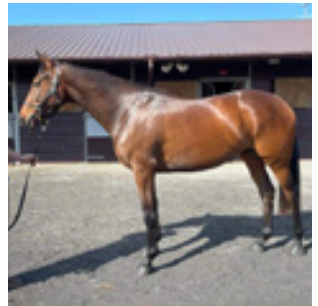

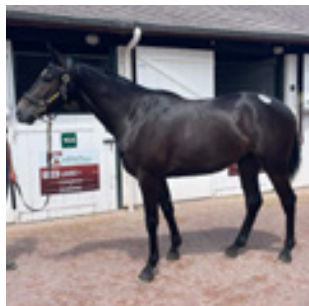
2019 Bay Gelding by Soldier Of Fortune (IRE) ex Tip Tap Toe (IRE) (Getaway)
